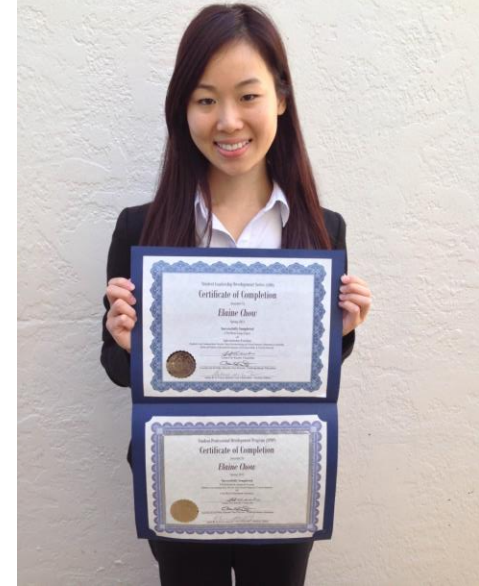

## Diversity Leadership Development Program

### What is DLDP?

DLDP is a certificate program designed to provide students the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding and appreciation of differences, learn how to effectively address complex issues, and learn how to cultivate a safe and inclusive environment in an organization or workplace.

### What are the benefits of DLDP?

- Learn communication and leadership skills vital to succeeding in a diverse workplace
- Build your resume through an internship experience
- Become competitive for graduate school and/or your job search
  - Earn a certificate of completion
- Earn Transcript Notation for Professional Experience

### What are the requirements for DLDP?

DLDP is a **3-quarter commitment**. To receive a certificate, students must attend 5 *Required* and 6 *Topical* sessions during Fall and Winter quarters for a total of 11 sessions. Students must also complete an *Professional Experience* during Spring or Summer quarter. The 2013-2014 session schedule is on the back side of this flyer.

To enroll in DLDP you must attend an Orientation Session.
