- Visiting International Student Programs
 - Education Abroad Program
 - Global Study Program
- Graduate Certificate Programs
 - Advanced Chemical Engineering
- Visiting Scholars
 - Generally research only

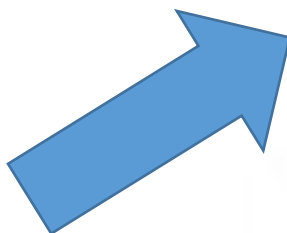


Open Campus

- Public access to UC Davis classes
- Registration occurs on a space-available basis through the Open Campus process – students not recorded in BANNER
- No ID card, minimal support services
- Typically continuing education or dismissed students seeking readmission

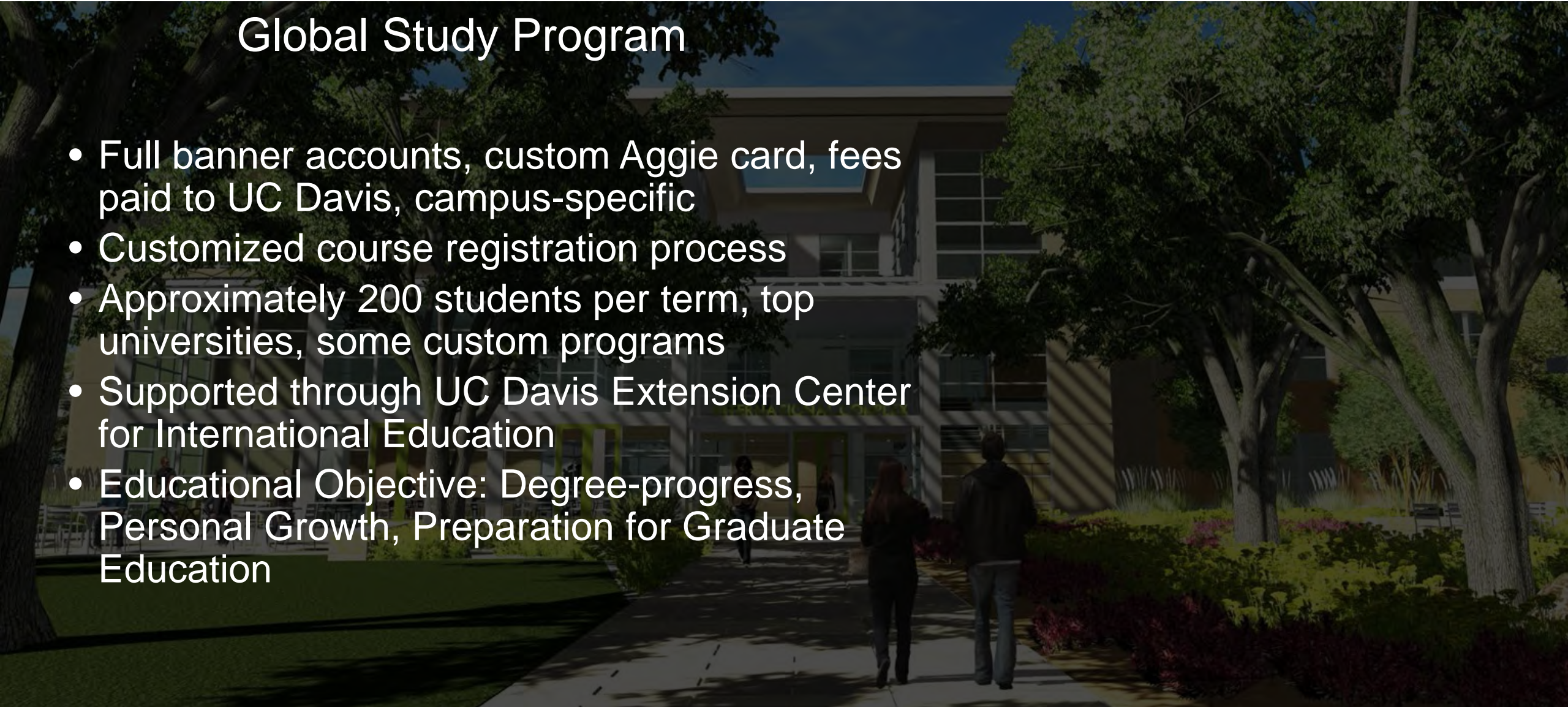

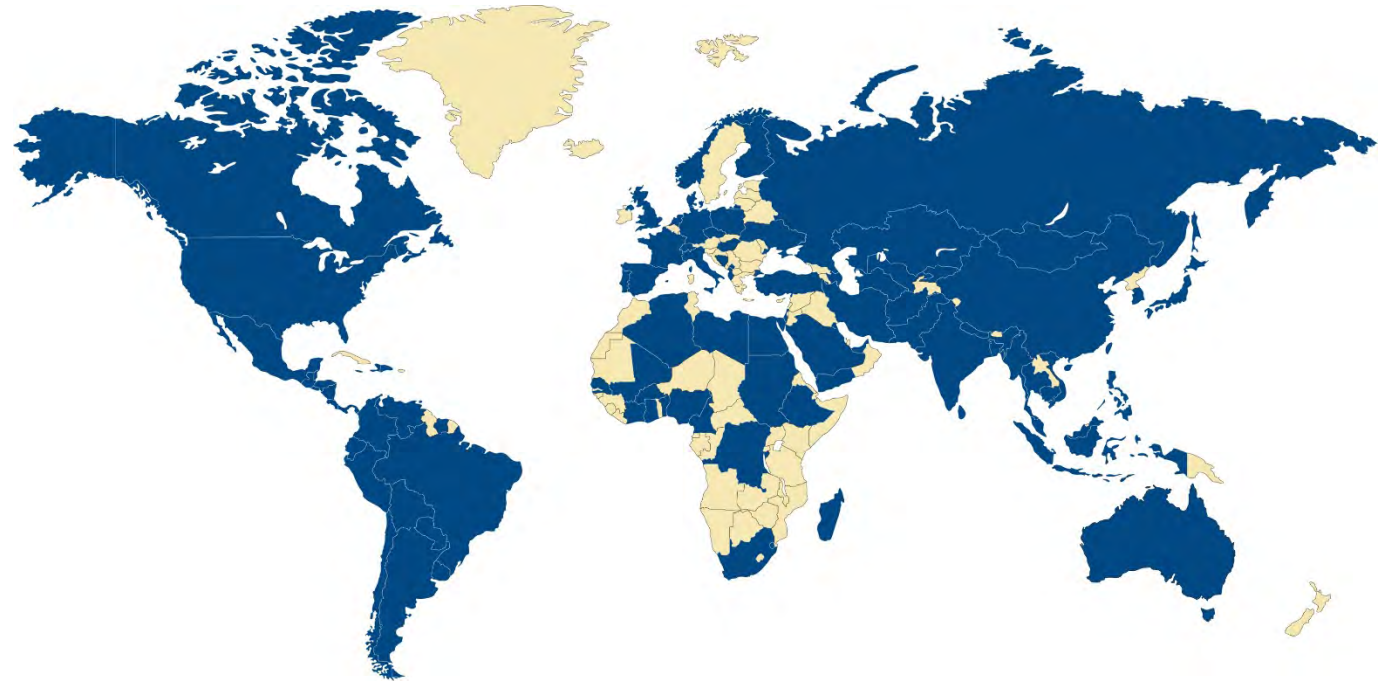
